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





Submit your application

To enroll into a course as an overseas student at Invicta, applicants must complete an International Student Enrolment Form available from our website www.invicta.edu.au.

The form should be completed in full and submitted via email to: admin@invicta.edu.au along with a copy of your passport, certificates of previous studies, and proof of English (IELTS/PTE/ELICOS).

Receive your Letter of Offer

When we receive your application, our team member will review it for completeness. When the application for enrolment is complete, you will be issued a Letter of Offer (valid 14 days), invoice for initial payment of fees and provided with a Student Agreement for your review.

04



Accept your offer and pay the initial fee

Once you accept the offer you are required to return the signed copy of the student agreement along with the receipt of initial payment of fees.

05



Receive your CoE

Upon approval of your application, an electronic confirmation of enrolment (eCoE) will be generated and forwarded to Department of Immigration and Border Protection and yourself at the address provided on your application with an official receipt for the fees paid.

06



Apply for student visa

If your student visa application is approved, you should contact us and provide evidence of approval. We will contact you to confirm your timetable, start date. If your student visa application is NOT approved, you must contact Invicta Technical College and advise us and apply in writing for a refund of student fees in accordance with our Fee Refund Policy.


